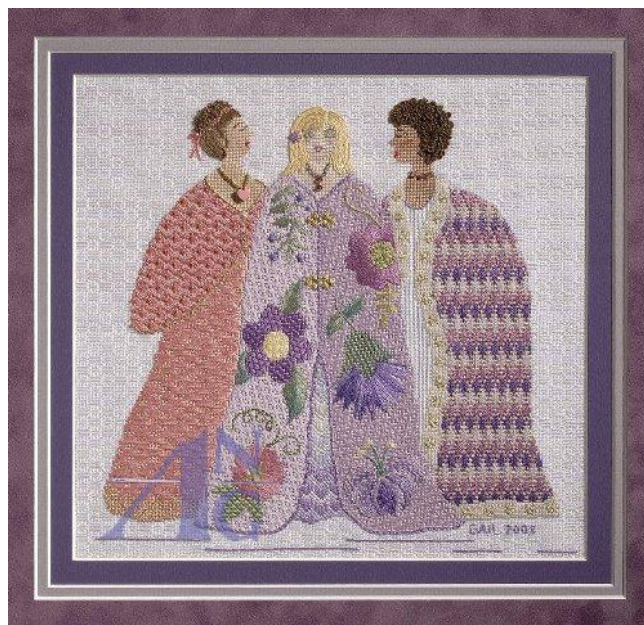


Gateway Chapter ANG Announces Fall Workshop by Gail Carolyn Sirna November 7 and 8, 2009

Project

This is a 9 ½” by 11” design on Congress Cloth of three beautiful women draped in colorful, flowing robes with jeweled necklaces. It features a combination of stitches and techniques, such as, diaper pattern couching, silk crewel embroidery, Chinese knots and stem stitch, and sophisticated canvaswork. The background is a subtle, tone-on-tone darning pattern in values of palest pink and lavender. Proficiency level is Intermediate. **Class size is limited to 20.**

Gail Carolyn Sirna’s needlework pieces have graced the cover of *Needlepoint Now* and have been on class schedules at many ANG and EGA National Seminars. She is an award-winning embroiderer and a regular columnist for *Needlepoint Now*.
